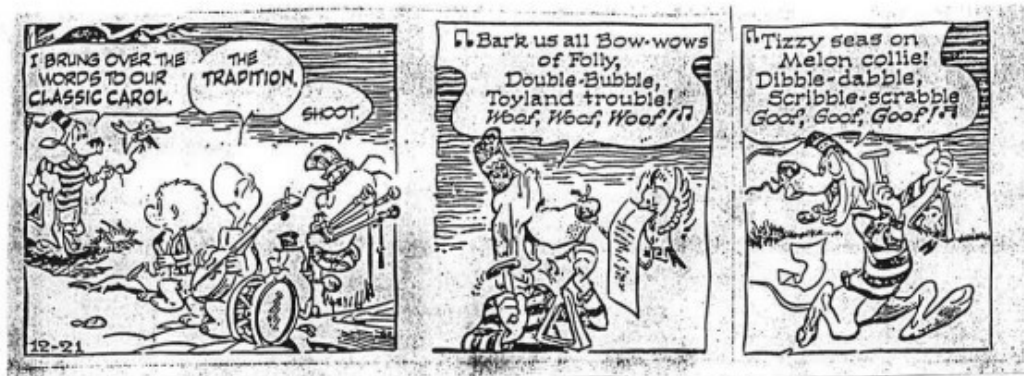
Deck us all with Boston Charlie
